From the funds raised with the help of cyclists like you, \$6000 from the Pioneer Spirit Trail fund was donated to the City of Hastings to help purchase the land for the final section of Phase 2. Now completed, this section connects Phase 1 with Phase 2 for a continuous 5.2-mile trail around Hastings. This trail connects Libs Park, Lake Hastings, Hastings College, Heartwell Park and the train station.

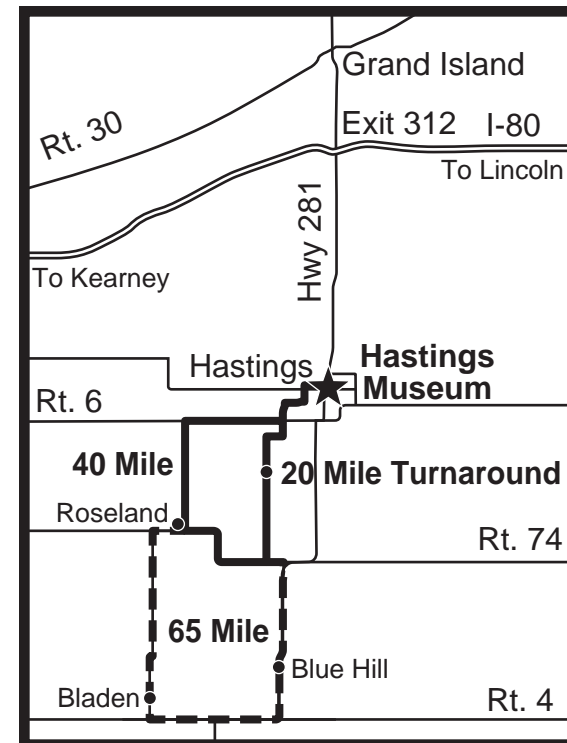

How to Get Here

Take Exit 312 from I-80. Turn South on Hwy 281 for about 16 miles. Turn East on 14th Street. Take the first right turn into the parking lot behind the Hastings Museum. Registration is at the shelter in Highland Park behind the train.

After the Ride

Showers are available after the ride at the Hastings YMCA on 16th Street. Join us at the Hastings Quality Hotel for an after-ride meal. Additional meals may be purchased for your family and friends who may not have participated in the ride.

Safety

Helmets are required. Roads are open to traffic, so please obey all traffic and safety rules. All riders must sign a waiver at registration. Riders under 18 years old must have a parent or guardian sign their waiver.
